Central Missouri's Zebrowski a Harlon Hill finalist, could repeat award win

CORSICANA – When the Central Missouri Mules face the University of Texas Permian Basin Falcons Saturday in Corsicana, fans will get to watch Harlon Hill Award finalist Zach Zebrowski. The Mules quarterback could become the fifth repeat winner of NCAA Division II football's most prestigious individual award.

Both teams boast prolific offenses, with UTPB led by two-time Lone Star Conference Wide Receiver of the Year Jeremiah Cooley.

Kickoff is scheduled for noon Dec. 7 at Community National Bank & Trust Stadium. Admission for Navarro County residents, and students of Navarro College, is free.

Both teams were playoff qualifiers just a year ago.

The Mules (8-3) have won five straight and closed the season with a 62-47 win over Missouri Southern. They average 39.1 points per game. The Falcons (7-4) have topped 60 three times this year, including twice down the final stretch of the season. They beat Sul Ross State, 75-7, in the season finale.

Zebrowski finished the regular season with 4,462 yards and 38 touchdowns passing, and another 461 and seven on the ground. He is one of eight finalists nationally.
